Information for

 The program evaluation is divided into several sections. The top portion is a review of the curriculum your coursework is evaluated against. This should be your current curriculum of study. The middle section is an overview of the number of credits required and how many were used to meet your degree requirements. The bottom section, consisting of two columns, is the coursework evaluation portion of your report. Your degree requirements are clustered into specific areas and sometimes groups. Each area lists the courses you have taken to meet the area requirement. Following the area title are the words met or not met, indicating your progress toward the completion of that area.

- This is NOT an official evaluation.
- Final approval is required by your department and the Registrar's office.
- Not all transfer work has been equated to SOU classes and may not show up in the Degree Evaluation reports. Check with your advisor, the Student ACCESS Center, or the Registrar's office on which transfer courses count towards your degree requirements.
- The evaluation does not include any exceptions, substitutes, or adjustments made by SOU.
- Areas met are contingent upon the satisfactory completion of in progress courses.
